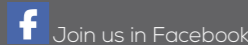

A MASTERY OF THE CRAFT, A PASSION FOR TRADITIONAL

Doreau, the cooper...

Born in Bourg-Charente, from farm worker parents, Thierry DOREAU pursued training as a carpenter-cabinet maker. After some experience, he began to work quite by chance for a cooperage: it was a revelation. He liked the job - working with the wood, the toasting process, and developing the aromatic potential of the oak. The young Frenchman was already dreaming of professional independence. At 20 years old, Thierry Doreau learned everything from his co-workers, whom he still respectfully calls his masters. At 25 years old, he created his company specialized in the repairs of barrels in Garancille. The story begins...

Doreau, the cooperage...

Created in 1989, nowadays it is 2 cooperages, Doreau and Vernou : with one production site in Gensac La Pallue near Cognac, 2 staves mills at Genouillac and Piegut, and a Workshop in Sigogne that specializes in the production of casks and tanks, as well as the repairs of Cognac barrels. The Doreau group continues to apply Thierry Doreau's expertise steeped in tradition, controlling every stage of the production, including the air dried seasoning. Just as a winemaker does with his grapes, we carefully choose our batches of wood to make the the best out of our blends. Every barrel in our Collection is completed with a harmonious toast, to enhance your wines and brandies, and respect their finesse and identities.
