

## **Packaging Materials**

We have information communicated by our packaging suppliers that they fully comply with the DL No. 407/98 of 21 December laying down the rules and general principles applying by the management of packaging and packaging waste, and in particular Article 2 and Directive 94/62 / EEC, which defines the packaging requirements for limiting concentration of heavy metals, in that the sum of Pb concentration levels - Lead Cd - Cadmium, mercury - mercury and Cr (VI) Hexavalent present in packaging is clearly less than 100 ppm by weight (more demanding limit, which entered into force on 1 July 2001).

They also declared that no additive used in our packaging is classified dangerous for the environment according to the European Directive 67/548 / EEC, and that their packaging may be recoverable in the form of material recycling, taking into consideration the continuous technological development in terms of packaging and recycling.
